Migratory Qualifying Worker

An individual who made a Qualifying Move and, soon after the move, engaged in new Qualifying Work.

What is a Migratory Child (MC)?

- 1. younger than 22 years of age;
- 2. entitled to a free and public education under State law;
- 3. Made a Qualifying Move as, with, to join or precede a Migratory Qualifying Worker

Qualifying Move

As, with, to join or precede





Migratory Qualifying Worker

Qualifying Arrival Date (QAD):

The date that both the Migratory Child and the Migratory Qualifying Worker complete their qualifying moves together.

The child must have moved as, with, to join or precede the Migratory Qualifying Worker. This date begins the child's 36 months of eligibility in the Migrant Education Program

What is a **Qualifying Move?**

A move made under the following conditions:

- due to economic necessity,
- from one residence to another,
- from one school district to another, and
- within the past 36 months





The child's and the Migratory Qualifying Worker's moves...

Due to economic necessity

Examples of Economic Necessity

- Not able to afford to stay in the current location
- Move in order to earn a living



The Migratory Child's and the Migratory Qualifying Worker's moves...

From one residence to another

to live and not just to visit.

Does not include:

- Visit family or friends
- Attend a wedding
- Take a vacation
- Take care of "legal" matters



The Migratory Child's and the Migratory Qualifying Worker's moves...

From one school district to another

Across school district lines

- From Texas to Louisiana
- From Mexico to Florida
- From Tangipahoa Parish to Jefferson Parish



The Migratory Child's and the Migratory Qualifying Worker's moves must be Qualifying Moves...

Due to economic necessity

A N D

Change of residence

From one school district to another

All criteria must be met

"As", "With",
"To-join" or
"precede" the
Migratory
Qualifying
Worker

- The Migratory Child moved "as" the Migratory Qualifying Worker
- The Migratory Child moved "with" the Migratory Qualifying Worker.
- The Migratory Child moved "to join" or "precede" the Migratory Qualifying Worker.

Qualifying Move Scenarios

Scenario 1

Daniela made a move with her father from Mexico to Grant Parish on 2/1/2021 so her father could work. Daniela is still enrolled in school in Mexico and is taking online classes.

Scenario 2

Jose moved from Grant Parish to Terrebonne Parish because rent was more affordable. He began working at a restaurant as soon as he arrived.

Scenario 3

Scenario 4

Marc, age 9, went from Plaquemines Parish to Jefferson Parish to be with his grandparents during Summer vacation because he enjoyed spending time with them. He was there for a month. His parents said that they send Marc to live with his grandparents because they needed the childcare and couldn't afford to send him to daycare.




