This manual is a living document and will be updated, amended or edited to reflect new regulations, different understandings or new qualifying activities.

Disclaimer

This Qualifying Activities Manual is a statewide snapshot of the qualifying activities that occur in the Louisiana Migrant Education Program. There may be instances in which a qualifying activity occur during different times in different parts of the state. This manual serves as a general guide for the qualifying activities in the state and may not necessarily be the rule when it comes to determining the eligibility of certain qualifying activities.

TEMPORARY VS. SEASONAL EMPLOYMENT

This Manual attempts to determine whether each qualifying activity in the Louisiana Migrant Education Program is qualified based on temporary or seasonal employment, or both. It is important to note that this manual is a guide and not necessarily the rule. Each recruiter is determining the nature of the Migratory Qualifying Worker's employment on an individual basis through the process of an eligibility interview.

When determining whether employment is seasonal or temporary, a recruiter focuses on the length of employment in addition to the qualifying activity. Regardless of the qualifying activity that the individual is engaged in, their employment must last less than 12 months in order to be considered temporary or seasonal. Please refer to Questions G3 and G5 of the Migrant Education Program Non-Regulatory Guidance below.

G3. How long may seasonal employment last?

The definition of seasonal employment in 34 C.F.R. § 200.81(o) states that it is employment that occurs only during a certain period of the year and may not be continuous or carried on throughout the year. Therefore, like temporary employment, seasonal employment may not last longer than 12 months.

G5. What is temporary employment?

According to 34 C.F.R. § 200.81(p), temporary employment means "employment that lasts for a limited period of time, usually a few months, but no longer than 12 months."

For example, an individual may be hired to perform several different "seasonal" tasks that lead to the individual being employed by the same employer for more than 12 months. In this case, the individual would not be employed on a seasonal or temporary basis. Please refer to Question G7 of the Migrant Education Program Non-Regulatory Guidance.

G7. Is a worker who was hired to perform a series of different jobs, which together lead to the worker being employed by the same employer for more than 12 months, employed on a temporary or seasonal basis?

No. Workers who are hired to work for more than 12 months by the same employer, regardless of how many different jobs they perform, are not "engaged in new temporary or seasonal employment" as provided in the definitions of migratory agricultural worker and migratory fisher in section 1309(2) and (4) of the ESEA. See also 34 C.F.R. § 200.81(o) and (p).

AGRICULTURE VS. FISHING

Please refer below to Questions F1 and F16 of the Migrant Education Program Non-Regulatory Guidance for the definitions of agricultural and fishing work.

F1. What is the definition of "agricultural work" for purposes of the MEP?

- "Agricultural work" is:
- 1. the production or initial processing of raw agricultural products, such as crops, poultry, or livestock; dairy work; as well as the cultivation or harvesting of trees, that is—
- 2. performed for wages or personal subsistence.

See section 1309(2) of the ESEA and 34 C.F.R. § 200.81(a).

F16. What is the definition of "fishing work" for purposes of the MEP?

- "Fishing work" is:
- 3. the catching or initial processing of fish or shellfish; as well as the raising or harvesting of fish or shellfish at fish farms, that is-
- 4. performed for wages or personal subsistence.

See 34 C.F.R. § 200.81(c).

QUALIFYING ACTIVITIES TABLE

The following is the list of qualifying activities in the Louisiana Migrant Education Program. The qualifying industry section indicates the industry in which the qualifying work is conducted. The second column, "Agriculture or Fishing" indicates whether the qualifying work is agricultural or fishing work. The third column, "Seasonal or Temporary" indicates whether the qualifying work is documented as seasonal or temporary. The fourth column, "Season" indicates what the typical season is for that qualifying work. Finally, the "Qualifying Activity" indicates the specific activity in which the Migratory Qualifying Worker engaged.

It is important to note, however, that this table is to be used as a guide and it may not always be 100% correct. Each COE is an assessment of that student's eligibility in the Migrant Education Program. For example, there may be instances where a Migratory Qualifying Worker is engaged in qualifying work that is documented as "Seasonal" in this table, but the qualifying work is in fact temporary.
